



REFUND POLICY

At MAP, we are committed to maintaining transparency and fairness in all our administrative processes, including our refund policy. We understand that enrolling in a program is an important decision, and we encourage all participants to review the following terms carefully before confirming their registration. Please note that all payments are strictly in Pound Sterling (GBP).

To ensure clarity and consistency, our refund policy is structured according to the time elapsed since the date of purchase:

Within 7 days of purchase:

Participants who request a refund within 7 calendar days of their purchase are eligible to receive a refund, minus a non-refundable administrative fee of £200.

Between 7 and 14 days of purchase:

Refund requests made between 8 and 14 calendar days from the date of purchase are eligible for a partial refund, with a £300 administrative fee deducted.

After 14 days of purchase:

Sadly, we are unable to offer any refunds for requests made more than 14 days after the date of purchase. At this point, substantial program administrative support have been allocated, and the seat is considered confirmed and non-transferable.

Final Deadline - No Refunds After Tuesday, November 18th 2025:

Please note that no refunds will be issued for any payments made on or after November 18th, regardless of the date of enrollment or circumstances. This policy is strictly enforced due to program logistics and planning requirements.

All refund requests must be submitted in writing via email to our support team and will be processed within a reasonable time frame once reviewed and approved. MAP reserves the right to deny refund requests that do not comply with the conditions outlined above.

PAYMENT INSTALLMENT POLICY

To make the payment process easier for our students, we are pleased to offer flexible installment payment plans for the comprehensive package of £2,499, or any customized package.

1. Payment Structure

Installments can be split into 2 or 3 payments, depending on the individual's request.

• Option 1 (2 payments):

£1,249.5 (first installment) £1,249.5 (second installment)


• Option 2 (3 payments):

Please note:

- Student must provide **provisional payment dates** for each installment before the plan is approved.
- If payments are not completed in full by the deadline i.e. Tuesday, 18th November 2025, no refund will be issued and the place may be forfeited.
- All installments must be paid in full through direct bank transfer to secure your place at the Islamic University of Madinah.
- All fees are non-refundable.


2. Additional Charges

- International customers will incur an additional charge to cover payment processing fees if the payment is made through Stripe.
- Payments made through direct bank transfer (recommended) will not incur any additional charges.
- We recommend direct bank transfer through Revolut as the preferred payment method due to its security, reliability and no transaction fees.

3. Purpose of Fees

- Securing your place at the Islamic University of Madinah requires the completion all installment payments.
- All fees are strictly non-refundable.
- Please note that **additional charges may apply** to cover payment processing fees (particularly for payments made via Stripe).
- These contributions are allocated directly toward essential arrangements, including:
- 1. Accommodation
- 2. Educational services
- 3. Excursions
- 4. Umrah preparations ADINAH ARABIC PROGRAM
- Failure to complete payments by the due date may result in the cancellation of your reservation.




DEPOSIT POLICY

To secure your place on the program, the following deposit terms apply:

- A minimum deposit of £500 is required to reserve a seat.
- Deposits are strictly non-refundable, under any circumstances.
- Spaces are limited and allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Students who wish to secure their spot immediately are encouraged to pay the deposit as soon as possible.
- The deposit amount will be deducted from the total course fee.
- Full course fees must be cleared by the specified deadline (Tuesday, 18th November 2025) failure to do so may result in the loss of your place and no refund will be issued.
- International customers are advised that payments made via Stripe will incur an additional processing fee. To avoid extra charges, we recommend using direct bank transfer (preferably through Revolut) as it is secure, reliable, and free of transaction fees.

MAP is **only** responsible for accommodation of students during the official program timings:


- Check-in: Thursday, 18th December 2025 at 2:00 pm
- Check-out: Saturday, 17th January 2026 at 2:00 pm

Important Notes:

- Accommodation outside these dates is not the responsibility of MAP.
 Participants arriving before 18 December 2025 or departing after 17
 January 2026 must arrange and cover the cost of their own accommodation.
- MAP does not provide transportation between the airport and the hotel. Participants are responsible for organising their own transfers (e.g., via Uber, Careem, taxi, or other local transport services).
- A Late check-out fee will incur if you do not check out at 2:00 pm on the 17th of January 2026.




ACCOMMODATION POLICY

MAP IN-HOUSE STUDENT CONDUCT POLICY

1. Scope and Responsibility

- MAP operates within the premises of the Islamic University of Madinah and is not responsible for the disciplinary outcomes of students within the institution.
- MAP holds no authority to interfere with decisions made by the Islamic University of Madinah administration regarding student conduct, including expulsion due to behavioral issues.

2. Expulsion and Misconduct

- If a student is expelled or faces disciplinary action due to misconduct, MAP bears no responsibility for the consequences.
- Disciplinary actions, including expulsion, are solely under the jurisdiction of the Islamic University of Madinah administration.

3. Dress Code & Shariah Compliance

- All students must adhere to the Shariah dress code, similar to the standard in any Islamic educational institution.
- Abaya and modest hijab must be worn in all public areas (outside the classroom); inside the classrooms of the University it may be removed as long as Islamic modesty is maintained.
- Students should avoid audible heels and wearing makeup in public areas on campus.
- Immodest dressing is strictly prohibited.
- Students will first receive advice and reminders from their Mushrifs and Mushrifahs. Repeated violations may lead to expulsion.


MAP IN-HOUSE STUDENT CONDUCT POLICY

STUDENT ETIQUETTES WITH TEACHERS IN THE ISLAMIC UNIVERSITY OF MADINAH

- Students must show adab (good manners) at all times speak respectfully, follow instructions, and avoid argumentation or disruptive behaviour.
- During lessons, students should remain attentive. If they wish to ask a question, they must raise their hand and wait for permission to speak.
- Students must not argue with, talk back to, or disregard instructions given by teachers. If a concern arises, it must be reported to the Mushrif or Mushrifah, who will address the matter through the appropriate channels.
- From the good manners of a student is to ask permission before you stand up, before you go to the bathroom and before you exit the classroom.
